

How to Help a Campaign Win



- **Volunteer or intern.**

Decide how much time you can commit to the campaign and apply to volunteer, or to become an intern if you want to play a greater role in the campaign.

- **How to find volunteer opportunities:**

- Check the campaign and political party's websites for applications.
- Contact your state, county, or local political party.
- Reach out directly to the campaign.

- **Do your research.**

Before you begin as a volunteer or intern, read the candidate's website and relevant news articles. Know the candidate's platforms. You will learn on the job, but be prepared to answer basic questions and speak on the campaign's main goals.

- **Get familiar with the constituency.**

Be familiar with the areas that fall under the municipality or district you will be working in. Who currently holds office and how do people feel about them? What concerns should you be prepared to address when communicating with potential voters?
